



Lloyd E. Mitzmyer

May 2, 1946 — October 14, 2012

Lloyd E. Mitzmyer, 66, Hays, died October 14, 2012 in an automobile accident south of Glade, Kansas.

He was born May 2, 1946 in Holdrege, Nebraska the son of Edward Lloyd and Rose (Fecht) Mitzmyer. He married Karen Schluntz on July 22, 1972 in Huntley, Nebraska. He attended elementary school at District #27 northwest of Orleans, Nebraska and graduated from Orleans High School. Lloyd was the chief electronics engineer for Smoky Hill Public Television. He attended National Electronics School in Denver, Colorado prior to entering the U.S. Navy during the Vietnam war. He served in the Navy from 1966 until 1972 and was aboard the USS Monticello from 1967 until 1968. Prior to moving to Hays, he was the chief engineer for ABC channel 13 in Kearney, NE. He was a member of the High Plains Baptist Church, Hays, the Hays American Legion, was president of the Praise Radio Network, Deacon and Missions treasurer at the High Plains Baptist Church, was a HAM radio operator and handyman, and loved to restore antique radios.

Survivors include his wife, of the home in Hays, daughters Tracy, Jody, and Katie Mitzmyer, all of Hays, and a sister Arlene Mitzmyer of Holdrege, Nebraska.

Funeral services will be at 3:00 pm on Thursday, October 18, 2012 at the High Plains Baptist Church, Hays. Burial with military honors by the Hays American Legion will be at 1:30 pm on Thursday at the Fort Hays Memorial Gardens Cemetery.
